Ceramic Artist and Instructor

Peter joined the School for American Crafts at RIT as Visiting Assistant Professor in Ceramics in Fall 2014. Peter received his BFA (2005) and MFA (2011) in ceramics from Alfred University, and in between was a resident artist at the Mendocino Art Center in Mendocino, California. His work has been exhibited in venues such as the Salon Art + Design, SOFA Chicago, Collective Design, Lewis Wexler Gallery, Duane Reed Gallery, Sherry Leedy Contemporary Art, Independent Art Projects at Mass MOCA, Greenwich House Pottery and National Council on Education for Ceramic Art. Peter's work can be found in numerous private and public collections.

Awards

\$1,000 in cash awards. Best in Show receives \$500.

Entry Fee

\$30 for entry of up to 3 images.

\$35 for entry of 4 to 6 images.

Once entry is submitted, fees are non-refundable regardless of acceptance into the exhibition.

Images

All entries must be submitted electronically via online *Submittable* platform. Follow all instructions listed on mainstreetarts.submittable.com. Judging will be done entirely from JPEGs. No other formats will be accepted. JPEGs must be 72 dpi, at least 1200 pixels in one direction.

Insurance

Artwork will be insured against loss, damage, or theft while on gallery premises. Artists should insure work during shipping to and from the gallery.

Shipping

Artists will pay shipping to and from gallery, pay close attention to shipping dates after notification of acceptance.

Sales

All sales will be handled by gallery staff at Main Street Arts. The gallery retains 40% commission on all sales, please price your work accordingly. All work accepted must be for sale. Online sales will be an option for artists who are selected for the exhibition. Sales made in Main Street Arts online store will be under the same terms as in-gallery sales.

Selected work

All entries must be of original design and personal execution. Artwork which differs greatly from submission images will not be accepted.

Your payment will serve as your acceptance of the terms and conditions stated in this prospectus.
